IF SOMETHING ISN'T CLEAR, ASK YOUR DOCTOR TO EXPLAIN IT IN A WAY YOU UNDERSTAND.

REQUEST ACCOMMODATIONS:

IF YOU NEED EXTRA HELP, LIKE MORE TIME OR AN INTERPRETER, ASK FOR IT.

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS:

THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA): THIS LAW GIVES YOU THE RIGHT TO ASK FOR ACCOMMODATIONS AT WORK, SCHOOL, AND IN PUBLIC SPACES.

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS SO YOU CAN ASK FOR WHAT YOU NEED, LIKE A FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE AT WORK OR EXTRA TIME FOR TESTS.

BUILD A SUPPORT SYSTEM:

JOIN SUPPORT GROUPS: CONNECTING WITH OTHERS WHO HAVE YOUR DIAGNOSIS CAN GIVE YOU COMFORT AND GOOD ADVICE.

LEAN ON FRIENDS AND FAMILY:

DON'T BE AFRAID TO ASK FOR HELP OR SHARE YOUR FEELINGS WITH THE PEOPLE YOU TRUST. TAKE CARE OF YOUR MENTAL AND EMOTIONAL HEALTH:

A NEW DIAGNOSIS CAN BE TOUGH EMOTIONALLY. IF YOU NEED IT, TALK TO A COUNSELOR AND TAKE CARE OF YOURSELF BY DOING THINGS YOU ENJOY. SET BOUNDARIES:

LET PEOPLE KNOW WHAT YOU CAN AND CAN'T DO. IT'S OKAY TO SAY "NO" OR TAKE TIME FOR YOURSELF.

1 pound 90%-lean ground beef

2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce

¹⁄₄ teaspoon salt ¹⁄₄ teaspoon ground pepper

4 slices Cheddar cheese

DRAIL'S MISSION

To partner with individuals with disabilities, their families, and their support teams to increase their independence, advocate for their rights, and create fully inclusive communities. 4 whole-wheat hamburger buns, toasted

- **4 leaves butter lettuce**
 - 4 slices tomato
 - 4 slices white onion
- 1/4 cup dill pickle chips

Directions

- Preheat air fryer to 375°F for 5 minutes. Combine beef, Worcestershire, salt and pepper in a medium bowl.
 Form the mixture into 4 (4ounce) patties, about 1/2-inch thick.
- Working in batches if necessary, arrange the patties in a single layer in the air-fryer basket. Cook, flipping once, until an instant-read thermometer inserted in the center registers 160°F, about 7 minutes. Top each patty with a cheese slice and cook until melted, about 30 seconds.
- Assemble the burgers on toasted buns with lettuce, tomato, onion and pickles.
